



PROJECT SCOPE

The Park District has identified a need to improve and potentially expand the Community Center to better meet the needs of youth programs (before/after school care, enrichment programs, summer camp). In addition to program space improvements, there is a need for additional office and administrative space, as well as the need to address aging roof systems at the Community Center. Middlefork School, which is attached to the Community Center, is in the early stages of planning a renovation, and both parties are currently working together to develop plans to address their respective needs in the most efficient manner possible.
