- c. Committee Meeting Date Discussion
 - i. Director Byron proposed dates for the upcoming committee meetings, and after discussion it was decided that the Administrative & Finance Committee will meet on June 23rd at 5:30pm to review the FY 25-26 tentative budget. It was recommended that a meeting between Park District and District 29 liaisons be scheduled prior to scheduling the first meeting of the FUND the Future Committee.
 - ii. A brief discussion was held regarding a future referendum. At this time, there was agreement amongst the Board that the March 2026 election is the current target for another attempt at a limiting rate referendum.

i. Director Byron provided updates on the Willow Park Phase 2 project, mentioning that permits are starting to be approved and staff are hopeful that late-June or early-July is still a realistic time frame for construction to begin. Byron also stated that staff are still in talks with IDNR regarding the language of the lease for the Tower Road right-of-way, and working to get clarification on whether it is eligible for OSALD Grant consideration. Grant applications are due by September 30th. Lastly, Byron mentioned that the netting canopy has been approved by the Village of Northfield and staff are working with potential contractors to finalize their cost estimates.
